Our testing environments are relaxed and pleasing. We allow time for nervous patients to talk through their fears. The scan itself usually takes less than an hour. Typically, your doctor receives our report within 24 hours. You will receive a personal copy of your MRI films for your permanent medical records.

Our MRI technology includes: two fixed Siemens 1.5 Tesla short-bore magnets at our primary site in Rochester Hills and two short-bore Siemens 1.5 Tesla Symphony mobile MRI units. All of our units deliver superb image quality. We provide service to seven convenient Metro-Detroit locations. Patients weighing up to 440 pounds are accepted. All centers provide convenient parking and are handicapped accessible.

MRI for Breast and Heart Disease, too!

Michigan Resonance Imaging offers technology and expertise to evaluate breast disease with MRI. A specially-designed breast coil makes this exam comfortable yet accurate. While Breast MRI does not replace routine mammography screening for most individuals, its high definition images may improve diagnosis for women with dense breasts which are difficult to image. It is also used to identify possible additional cancers in both breasts, and provide guidance for needle or percutaneous biopsy when required.

If you have been diagnosed with breast cancer, discuss breast MRI with your clinician. Our service is also expanding into Cardiac MRI, to assess cardiac health.
